



DIY Idea: Two-storey geranium hanging basket for small balconies

You will need:



- Two metal plant pots
- Two square wooden discs with holes and circular recesses
- Spray paint
- Sturdy coloured string
- A darning needle, scissors
- Two geraniums in the colour of your choice

Important: Make sure the side length of the wooden discs is larger than the upper pot diameter. It is best to have the wooden discs cut to size at a DIY shop. In addition to circular recesses in the centre, they must have holes in all four corners which the string will be pulled through later on.

Method:

- 1) Spray the cut wooden discs in the colour of your choice and let them dry.
- 2) With the darning needle, pull four pieces of string of the same length through the pre-drilled holes in the corners and tie them with knots at the desired distance from each other. It is best to use doubled up string.
- 3) Place the plant pots in the recesses and tie the free ends of the four strings together to make a loop for hanging.
- 4) Finally, place the geranium pots in the metal pots and hang the finished decoration in a suitable place. Job done!
