



Upcycling idea: a candelabra becomes a geranium hanging basket, bird home and butterfly hotel



You will need:

- Old candelabra chandelier
- Nesting box
- Butterfly house
- Metal planters
- Hot glue
- Spray paint
- Geraniums

How to build:

- 1.) Attach the bird nesting box, butterfly house and metal planters to the candle plates on the chandelier arms using hot glue. If gluing is impossible due to pins on the candle plates, drill small holes in the nesting box, butterfly house and planters.
- 2.) Add some colour with spray paint, or use a brush.
- 3.) Plant geraniums in the planters (don't forget to drill drainage holes). Self-cleaning trailing geraniums are especially suitable as they are low maintenance.
- 4.) Finally, hang the chandelier in a secluded spot. Make sure your geraniums get enough sunlight!
